COPI Notice

The Notice served under Regulation 3(4) of the Health Service Control of Patient Information Regulations 2002 (the COPI Notice) has now been <u>extended until March 2021</u>. The Notice has mandated data sharing and processing for a Covid-19 purpose.

A Covid-19 purpose could include but is not limited to:

- Understanding Covid-19 and risks to public health
- Identifying and understanding information about patients or potential patients with or at risk of Covid-19
- Delivering services to patients, clinicians, the health services
- Research and planning in relation to Covid-19
