Access to records update

As you will be aware, NHS England have dictated in the recently imposed GP contract that <u>31st October</u> is now the deadline for the requirement of enabling patients to have access to prospective data in the GP record, via the NHS app and other equivalent apps.

On September 13th Jane Hill, GP Practice appointed DPO, and Dr Amir Hannan, MBE met with Tristan Stanton, NHS England's Programme lead for the Accelerated Citizens Access to Health Records programme. Both Jane and Dr Hannan flagged that there are ongoing concerns and significant risks with the proposal of enabling access en masse. These risks include clinical risks, inadequate redaction software, and workload pressures. On behalf of The Association of GM LMCs, the attached update was shared with all GPs and Practice Managers across Greater Manchester. It was also shared with the BMA-GP Committee Chair Dr Katie Bramall-Stainer, who welcomed the update and confirmed that further BMA guidance on this will be published in the next couple of weeks.

I have also attached guidance on redaction and hiding documents from patient view, which you may wish to share with your practice team.
